SB71 establishing a commission to study the feasibility of regional transit. (ITL)

SB75 changing the formula for distribution of highway funds in the Woodsville fire district. (Passed Signed by Governor Chapter 0147)

SB111 authorizing the governor to appoint an additional public member to the rail transit authority and modifying the membership requirement of the state veterans' advisory committee (Passed Signed by Governor Chapter 0055)

HB34 relative to rules of the road (Passed Adopted)

HB49 relative to stop and haul charges for milk. (Retained in Committee)

HB54 requiring vehicle impoundment for driving after revocation or suspension (ITL)

HB68 relative to commercial driver licenses when the license holder fails a drug or alcohol test. (ITL)

HB76 establishing a permanent commission to study recommendations of the National Transportation Safety Board. (Passed Signed by Governor Chapter 0150)

HB95 relative to motorcycle equipment and noise levels (ITL)
