Be Aware...

- ◆ All 50 States have adopted Move Over Laws
- ◆ 70% of Americans don't know these laws exist
- ◆ The Emergency Responder Safety Institute reports that on average about **70 first responders** (6-8 fire rescue and EMS, 10-12 police officers, and 50 tow truck operators) are killed on the roadways each year
- ◆ Move Over laws are in effect on all roadways

What is the Move Over Law?

The Move Over Law requires drivers to change lanes to give safe clearance to the first responders on or near the roadway. If the driver cannot move to another lane, the law requires drivers to slow down to **20 miles below the posted speed.**
